BAKER Frederick John, Herbert Charles, Alfred Charles, and Robert

BAKER Josiah and **THOMPSON Bridget** were the parents of these four Baker brothers, who are buried in **Saint Peter's Cemetery**, Onehunga.

Josiah BAKER (1842-1912) the son of John BAKER and Eliza AUSTIN was born in Wellington, Somerset, England.

Bridget THOMPSON (1842-1917) the daughter of **James THOMPSON** and **Margaret Annie RYAN** was born in Fermoy, County Cork, Ireland. The Thompson were **a Fencible family**, who came to New Zealand on the *Sir Robert Sale*, arriving in Auckland 11 October 1847. They settled in Howick.

Josiah and Bridget were married in New Zealand on 17 July 1862.

They gave birth to thirteen children born, four of whom were buried in **St Peter's Cemetery** (Plot 322)
